The Heights School

Community Defibrillator

EGRA continue to work with Emmer Green Patients Group to provide a life – saving community defibrillator which was originally suggested by an EGRA member. We will keep you posted with updates.

Daffodil Planting

EGRA and a team of volunteers replanted 1000 daffodil bulbs, in October 2015, on the green opposite St. Barnabas Church. The daffodils are in full bloom and we hope that you have all enjoyed them. We would like to thank Margaret Ormonde for arranging the supply of the bulbs through Reading Borough Council's Decent Neighbourhood Fund.

Tree Planting

EGRA and GLOBE are working closely with the tree wardens to replace trees. On January 21st 2016 they planted a new oak tree at Emmer Green shopping precinct.

Planning

EGRA continues to monitor Reading Borough Council's weekly planning lists. As the economy picks up and the demand for new housing increases, there are bound to be additional pressures.
